Worship Volunteers Needed

We are in need of volunteers to assist with worship. Some positions are for coverage when weekly volunteers need to be out. Others are to be part of a scheduled rotation where you would not be asked to volunteer every week. All volunteers are safely socially distanced from one another during the service. The following volunteer positions are available:

- Liturgists (read scripture and other liturgy during worship) - We have a schedule of individuals who served as scripture readers prior to the pandemic. However, some may not be able to return right now, so we are asking for additional volunteers.
- Livestream Coordinators - These individuals run the livestream laptop and remote camera controls. They are not difficult to use, and training is provided.
- Worship Slides - These individuals run the Proclaim computer to manage the worship slides shown in both the sanctuary and on the livestream. Training is provided.
- Sound Technician - These volunteers help manage the sound board for the sanctuary and/or livestream feed. Training is provided.

Our Sanctuary is Open on Sundays!

You can still worship remotely by Facebook or YouTube. Just click on the Facebook or YouTube logos at the bottom of this bulletin to access our pages. However, we are also happy to have our sanctuary open once again for worship on Sunday mornings at 10:30 AM. Safety standards are in place. We have masks, hand sanitizer, and even gloves for anyone who needs them. We do ask you to wear a mask, although we sit distanced apart enough to be able to remove them for Communion.

Soap & Wash Cloths Needed

There is currently enough food to distribute, but hygiene items are running low, especially soap and wash cloths.
