Worship Volunteers Needed

We are in need of volunteers to assist with worship. Some positions are for coverage when weekly volunteers need to be out. - Liturgists (read scripture and other liturgy during worship) - We have a schedule of individuals who served as scripture readers prior to the pandemic. However, some may not be able to return right now, so we are asking for additional volunteers.
- Livestream Coordinators - These individuals run the livestream laptop and remote camera controls. They are not difficult to use, and training is provided.
- Worship Slides - These individuals run the Proclaim computer to manage the worship slides shown in both the sanctuary and on the livestream. Training is provided.
- Sound Technician - These volunteers help manage the sound board for the sanctuary and/or livestream feed. Training is provided.
