Donate Poinsettias

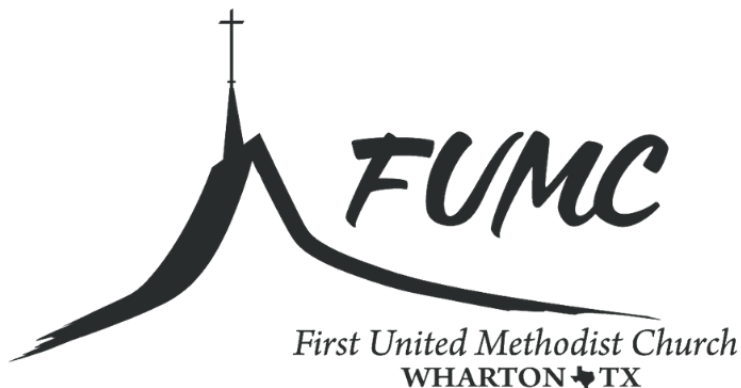
